

Quick Reference Guide

Dress Code Short List:

Top: Monday-Thursday: any color solid Polo style, Friday: Gold or Navy Polo style

Bottom: Solid colored, 4 pocket blue jeans pants or shorts, skorts or dresses (mid-thigh shorts/dress and no cargo please)

Belt: Black or brown

Field Trips: Solid colored, 4 pocket blue jeans with spirit shirt.

Free Dress and School Accessories (backpacks, pencil boxes, folders, etc.): must be without emblems, characters or advertisements. It is permissible to have prints that reflect Christian principles. If in doubt, ask your child's teacher.

Backpack: Must be clear.

Food:

Students should bring nutritious lunches for the noon meal. If meat is brought, please abide by the Biblical guidelines of clean and unclean meat. If in doubt, please reach out to the teacher. Please do not send an excessive amount of sweets or any beverages containing caffeine.

Financial:

Tuition: \$310 for Adventist and \$325 for Non-members for 10 months, due 1st of each month. \$35 late fee assessed after the 5th of each month.

School Attendance

School is from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. On Fridays, classes dismiss at 2:00 p.m. If a child arrives at school after 10:30 a.m., he/she will be marked a ½ day absence. If a child is picked up from school before 2:00 p.m., he/she will be marked a ½ day absence. On Friday's a child will be marked ½ day absence if picked up before 1:00 p.m.

School begins at 8:00 a.m. Students who arrive after 8:10 a.m. will be counted as tardy. Students who do not exceed 3 **unexcused** tardies in a nine-week period may participate in a special incentive reward.
